



FRIENDS ACCOUNTS 2016

At the end of 2016, the total income into the Friends accounts since 2005 was £ 28,447.08 (for the UK Friends account) and € 28,711.88 (for the German Friends account). As always, there were no other expenditures, as all administrative and other costs for running the Friends are borne by Biosphere Expeditions so that 100% of funds paid into the Friends accounts can go towards supporting our scientists and projects in the field.
