# Here are a few examples of what we have achieved through donations:

On the Azores whales and dolphins project, we have provided our scientists with funding to attend an international scientific conference to present their findings.



We have built a field research station in Namibia, which is used by research bodies year-round. It functions as an important centre for conservation, providing training and a hub for researchers, as well as employment for the local community.

In Oman we have purchased camera traps to help local researchers in their Arabian leopard conservation work. We have also funded an Omani ranger to join our Caprivi expedition as part of his training.



On our Honduras coral reef expedition we have purchased buoys and markers to delineate the protected area to make clear where the no-fishing zones start.



On many of our expeditions & projects, we produce and distribute information and education materials to local children and adults about the importance of wildlife, natural resources and how to protect them and their livelihoods.
